By downloading and/or using the SVG file set, you (“license holder”) agree to follow terms and conditions of this End User Licensing Agreement (EULA).

END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT

1. Commercial and Personal Use

SVG purchases are for Personal Use Only – Purchasing this allows for unlimited personal use. Personal use is defined as making something for yourself, or making something for a friend as a gift.

If you plan to sell a final end-product using this design, you will need to add on a small commercial use license. This means if you plan to make a coffee mug or a t-shirt using this file, and place the coffee mug or t-shirt up for sale, you will need a commercial license.

You may only sell finished, physical products. The Basic Commercial SVG License allows for sales in quantities of 1,000 or fewer items. The Basic Commercial SVG License does not prohibit multiple product types as long as the sale quantity does not exceed 1,000 items. This means you may use the same SVG file set to create a shirt design and a coffee mug design for sale, but the quantity of both items for sale must not exceed 1,000 items.

Purchase of another Basic Commercial SVG License is required when sales quantities exceed 1,000 items.

2. Digital products

Resale of SVG file sets, whether in original format or an alternate digital format, is prohibited. You may not use SVG file sets as a digital download.

3. Handmade and Physical products to sell

You may create physical products for sale. Physical products may include things like t-shirt designs, jewelry, paper crafts & products, coffee mugs, and other decor.

4. POD (Print on Demand)

Print on Demand services require a separate license. Please inquire.

5. Third Party Resale or Licensing Transfer

All licenses are non-transferable.

You may NOT resell the file set.

6. Distributing or sharing

SVG file sets may not be sublicensed, resold, or distributed by any license holder. You may not give the SVG file set away for free. You may not sell the file set. You may not share it with friends or colleagues.

7. Additional Terms of Use

By downloading and/or using the SVG file set, the license holder agrees to follow terms and conditions of this End User Licensing Agreement (EULA).

A Basic Commercial License is a Desktop License which includes one license per file set. Desktop licenses are non-exclusive, non-transferable, worldwide licenses.

Each purchase is for a single user or “seat” on up to 3 of their own devices. Work computers are not included unless you work from home. A single “user” is one individual person.
